## NO MORE QUARANTINE FOR INTERNATIONAL TRAVELLERS FROM FEBRUARY 14, 2022

The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare has announced new guidelines for international travellers coming to India. The new guidelines will be effective from February 14, 2022.

India has announced the cancellation of the 7-day quarantine for foreign arrivals, and recommends self – monitoring for 14-days. The need for undertaking RT-PCR test on the eighth day and uploading the same on Air Suvidha portal has also been dispensed with.

According to the new guidelines, all foreign arrivals must fill a self-declaration form (available at the Air Suvidha portal), including a travel history of the past 14 days.

Travellers are required to upload a negative RT-PCR test conducted within 72 hours of the travel date.

Alternatively, they can also upload a certificate confirming they have received both vaccine doses. This option, however, is only available to countries with mutual recognition of Covid vaccine certificates with India. For current list of countries <u>click here</u>
